II Kings Chapter 9

The Rise of Jehu

Jehu



- General over Israel's army.
- Anointed by a son of the prophets to be the next king.
- Was commissioned to destroy the house of Omri/Ahab.

Race to Jezreel

- King Joram (Israel) is recuperating at Jezreel.
- King Ahaziah (Judah) is with him.
- Jehu races toward Jezreel.
- Messengers sent to meet Jehu join him.



Assassinations

- Jehu kills Joram with an arrow.
- Bidkar ("son of stabbing", my FAVORITE name) casts Joram's body in Naboth's field.
- Ahaziah is captured and killed at Megiddo.



Death of Jezebel



- Jezebel taunts Jehu from a window.
- Jehu calls for her to be thrown down and some of her servant do so.
- Jehu and his men run over her body with their chariots.
- When they go to retrieve her body, the dogs had eaten it except for her skull, feet, and hands.

II Kings Chapter 10

The Reign of Jehu

Slaughter of the House of Omri

- Jehu sends a letter to Samaria and they kill the 70 sons of Ahab there.
- Jehu kills all that remain of Ahab in Jezreel.
- 42 relatives of Ahaziah are captured and killed.




Slaughter of the Priests of Baal

- Jehu tricks the followers of Baal into gathering.
- He has 80 men appointed to kill them all.
- The images of Baal are destroyed.
- The temple is made into a latrine.



Jehu's Reign

- Reigns 28 years.
- Fought Baal worship but followed Jeroboam's counterfeit worship.
- He was weak against the Syrians and Assyrians
- His son Jehoahaz inherits the throne.



II Kings Chapter 11

Athaliah and Jehoash

Athaliah


- Daughter of Ahab and Jezebel.
- Was the widow of King Jehoram of Judah.
- Took power after her son Ahaziah is killed by Jehu.
- First queen to reign over the Jews.
- First non-Davidic ruler over Judah.
- Solidifies her place by killing other possible heirs (children and grandchildren included) to the throne.



Jehoash/Joash

- The infant Jehoash escapes when hidden in the Temple for six years.
- The priests lead a revolt against Athaliah by proclaiming the boy as king.
- He is seven years old.





Death of Athaliah

- Athaliah goes to the Temple to find out what is happening.
- She cries, "Treason! Treason!".
- The guards capture her and execute her outside the Temple.

Jehoiada

- The High Priest Jehoiada is the mastermind behind the revolt.
- He leads the people into a revival.
- Baal worship is destroyed.
- He is a strong spiritual leader in the land for as long as he lives.



II Kings Chapter 12

Jehoash's Rise and Fall

Jehoash

- Reigns 40 years.
- Did right as long as Jehoiada lived.
- Did not restore united worship by allowing the high places to continue.



Repair of the Temple

- The Temple is about 150 years old.
- Money is collected to repair it.
- The first donations were either stolen or misappropriated.
- Finally, a system is set up to ensure the money was used properly.



Syrian Invasion

- Hazael of Syria led a campaign against the Philistines.
- He then turns to Jerusalem.
- Jehoash pays tribute to him from the treasuries of the Temple and the royal family.



Assassination of Jehoash

- We will cover more of his life in II Chronicles.
- He is killed by two of his servants.
- His son Amaziah takes the throne.



II Kings Chapter 23

Jehoahaz, Jehoash, Jeroboam

Jehoahaz

- Reigned 17 years.
- Not a good king.
- Did seek the Lord when the Syrians invaded.
 - God gave them a "saviour"
 - Probably his son.
- Joash/Jehoash inherits the throne.



Jehoash

- Reigned 16 years.
- Bad, followed Jeroboam's religion.
- His son Jeroboam II inherits the throne.




Elisha and Jehoash

- Through an object lesson with a bow and arrows, it is revealed that:
 - Israel will be delivered from Syrian oppression.
 - Israel will win three battles.
 - If only Jehoash had struck more times...

One more miracle...

- Elisha dies.
- The Moabites invade the land.
- At a funeral the people see the Moabites coming.
- They hurriedly place the body in Elisha's crypt.
- The man comes back to life after touching Elisha's remains.



War with Syria


- Conflicts continue with Syria.
- No real gains are made as long as Hazael was their king.
- Hazael died and his son Benhadad III inherits the Syrian throne.
- Israel is able to defeat Benhadad and reclaim lost territory.

II Kings Chapter 14


Amaziah to Zachariah

Amaziah

- Reigned 29 years.
- A good king.
- Did not destroy the high places.
- Had his father's assassins killed and followed Deuteronomy 24:16 in doing it.
- Led a campaign against Edom.




Battle of Bethshemesh



- Amaziah challenges Jehoash and Israel to battle.
- Judah is soundly defeated and Amaziah captured.
- 600 feet of Jerusalem's walls are destroyed, and the city is spoiled.

Amaziah's End

- A conspiracy arises against Amaziah.
- He flees Jerusalem to Lachish.
- He is assassinated there and buried in Jerusalem.
- His son Azariah is given the throne.



Jeroboam II

- Reigns 41 years.
- Follows the ways of his namesake.
- Strengthens and expands the Northern Kingdom.
- vs. 25 –JONAH!
- His son Zachariah inherits the throne.




EARTHQUAKE!!!

- There is a major earthquake in 786 B.C.
- Amos and Zechariah both mention it.
