


#### **BEATS PER MEASURE**

- Irregular 5, 7, etc.



# **NOTE VALUES**




• Think of it as a fraction:


• 2 = half



#### **BEWARE OF TIME CHANGES!**


In "Christ Receiveth Sinful Men", the verse is in 3/4 time but the chorus in 12/8.





# LEADING COMPOUND TIME

- While you \*can\* do every beat it is not necessary.
- You can "simplify" and use the same patterns for 2, 3, and 4 beats per measure.







You don't have to lead with 6 beats per measure. BEST - 2 beats per measure. ACCEPTABLE-ISH - two sets of 3 beats per measure.






You don't have to lead with 6 beats per measure. BEST - 2 beats per measure. ACCEPTABLE-ISH - two sets of 3 beats per measure.





You don't have to lead with 9 beats per measure. BEST - 3 beats per measure.





This is a very special case that we mentioned earlier. The verse is a straightforward 3 beats per measure. The chorus shifts into 12/8 time.

BEST - 4 beats per measure.

ACCEPTABLE-ISH - two sets of 2 beats per measure.
